Path No.	Nature Of Way	Description
32/1	Footpath	Capel Seion – Cwmmawr road to Wern-uchaf. Starts from Classified (Capel Seion – Drefach) Road between Myrtle and Fernhill. North-east up hillside on east side of old quarry and through fields to join F.P. 32/2 west of Wern-uchaf Farm.
32/2	Footpath	Woodlands Terrace, Drefach to Wern Lodge. Starts from Classified (Carmarthen – Cross Hands) Road north-west of Woodlands Terrace. South-west along access road to Wern-uchaf and through farmyard to continue W.N.W. along cart- road to Wern-isaf and westwards along access road to the Classified (Capel Seion – Mansel Arms) Road at Wern Lodge.
32/3	Footpath	Gellideg to boundary (near Gors). Starts from Classified Road (passing Mynyddcerig School) north-east of Gellideg. South-east along access road to Gors Farm as far as boundary along stream which is crossed by footbridge. (Way continues as F.P. 59/1 into Pontyberem).
32/4	Footpath	Mynyddcerig School to Efailfach. Starts from Classified Road on the south-west side of Mynyddcerig School. South-east along access road as far as Parish Boundary at Efailfach. (Way continues as F.P. 59/2 into Pontyberem Parish).
32/5	Footpath	Plasyfer to Parish Boundary. Starts from Classified (Rhydolau – Tanycoed-uchaf) Road at bend and on east side of Pantyfer. South-west across field to Parish Boundary south of Blaenberem. (Way continues as F.P. 30/39 into Llangendeirne Parish).
32/6	Footpath	From the Capel Seion to Bancffosfelen road west of Bryn-Celyn, and going north to Panty-Gwyn, through yard, and through fields passing Llwyn-y-Fienc and Banc-y-Ddraenen on the east side and along an access track to the Unclassified Road from Capel Seion to Llanddarog (SN506 133 to 508 139).
32/7	Footpath	Gellideg to Banc-y-gelli. Starts from Classified Road (passing Mynyddcerig School) north-east of Gellideg. Northwards through fields and out to the Unclassified (Mount Pleasant – Rhyd-yr-eirin) Road west of Banc-y-gelli.
32/8	Footpath	Pentre Sare to Tygwyn-bach. Starts from Unclassified (Mount Pleasant – Rhyd-yr-eirin) Road east of the access to Pentre Sare. North-east along north side of hedge, continuing across rough open land to pass west of Ty'r-felin at north-western end of access lane from Mount Pleasant. North-west across field, crossing stream by footbridge, northwards along cart-road to pass Garn Farm and north-east along access road out to the Classified (Capel Seion – Mansel Arms) Road north-west of Tygwyn-bach.
32/9	Footpath	Banc-y-gelli to F.P. 32/8. Starts from Unclassified (Mount Pleasant – Rhyd-yr-eirin) Road west of Banc-y-gelli. Northwards across rough open land for about 75 yards to meet F.P. 32/8.

Path No.	Nature Of Way	Description
32/10	Footpath	Llidiart-y-clo to Llanddarog School. Starts from Classified (Porthyrhyd – Crwbin) Road on north-east side of Llidiart-y-clo. North-west along access road to Glanyrynys Farm, through wicket-gate and across fields (crossing Rivers Dulais, Gwendraeth Fach and two streams by footbridges) to meet the access road to Lodge Farm after passing copse on west side. Out along access road to the Classified (Carmarthen – Cross Hands) Road on the west side of Llanddarog School.
32/11	Footpath	Llanddarog School to Rose Villa. Starts from F.P. 32/10 about 150 yards south of the Carmarthen – Cross Hands road at Llanddarog School. South-west along access to Pen-llwyn-io Farm, through yard and north-west through fields out to the Classified (Llanddarog – Cwm-isfael) Road about 270 yards north-east of Rose Villa.
32/12	Footpath	Cwm-isfael – Tir-eithin road to boundary. Starts from the Classified (Cwm-isfael – Tir eithin) Road about 70 yards south of Felin-uchaf. N.N.W. between the highway and the River Bantwen for about 40 yards to cross the river and the boundary by stepping stones. (Way continues into Llangendeirne as F.P. 30/5 to Pedair Heol).
32/14	Footpath	Rose Villa, Llanddarog to Penycwm. Starts from the Classified (Llanddarog-Cwm-isfael) Road about 170 yards south-west of Rose Villa. North-west along access road through fields to Cwmcoch Farm (three field gates en route), over stone bridge across stream and through Penycwm Wood to the Classified (Cwm-isfael – Tir-eithin) Road north of Penycwm Farm.
32/15	Footpath	Cross Hands/Llanddarog by-pass, south of Bancsych to Penrhiw. Starts from a stile on the southern boundary of the Cross Hands/Llanddarog by-pass near Bancsych Farm then runs south-east and then south-west through fields to Classified (Cwm-isfael-Tireithin) Road near Penrhiw Farm.
32/16	Footpath	The path leads off county road 220 yards north-west of Gelli-dywyll. It proceeds in a north-easterly direction, to enter Llanarthney, where it continues as Path No. 31/37 to link with county road near Garn-wen.
32/17	Footpath	The path starts at the county road opposite Gwynfryn, Llanddarog. It then runs in a north-westerly direction via Capel Newydd to the new trunk road. It then turns westwards and runs along the boundary of the trunk road for approximately 30 metres to a stile. The path recommences at a stile on the opposite side of the trunk road and goes in a northerly direction for approximately 20 metres to meet the road to Wernbongam.
32/18	Footpath	From the county road opposite Lan Fach and going west to link road. Restarts on west of link road and goes west via Cwrt y Draenog then south to the trunk road boundary where it turns north-west along the boundary for 40 metres to a stile. Restarts on the south side of the trunk road, via a stile,

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		and goes south-east for 40 metres, then south via Ty-welan to join the minor road near Llys Deri (SN 521 167 to 516 162).
32/19	Footpath	The path leads off county road at Pont Lan-Lucis. It proceeds in an easterly direction along Gwendraeth Fach river, to link with county road via Felin Fach Farm.
32/21	Footpath	Recommencing at a stile on the northern boundary of the trunk road and runs westwards for approximately 50 metres, then turns north-east along route of old road to a stile.
32/22	Footpath	From Pentre-dolau, via Ty'r Garn to road opposite Garn Ffrwd.
32/23	Footpath	From Footpath 31/51, at a footbridge, in a south-easterly direction via two footbridges, via a wicket gate, then south, to the Porthyrhyd highway. Length – 180 metres. Width 1.8 metres (SN517 177 to 518 176).
